5. Explain the procedure producing pain and distress.

The protocol includes models of severe acute illness. We will provide preemptive Buprenorphine SR (0.12-0.24 mg/kg) to minimize pain, discomfort and distress. In addition, fluids (10 mL/kg saline up to 30 mL/kg) will be given when mean blood pressure (determined with an arterial (carotid) pressure monitor or telemetry device) falls below 70% of the pre LPS value and glucose will be given to maintain glycemia above 60 mg/dL. Blood pressure, temperature, respiration rate and clinical score will be used to monitor (every 30 min) LPS challenged and septic pigs. A similar approach will be used to monitor ischemic pigs (in addition we may include abdominal NIRS if available). Control pigs will be paired fed to their septic counterparts and it is likely that they will not have access to feed for 50-60 h, which will cause discomfort.

6. Provide the scientific justification for not providing the appropriate anesthetics, analgesics, or tranquilizing drugs during procedures where the animal experienced accompanying pain or distress greater than momentary or slight.

Pain and distress cannot be relieved because the use of analgesics (both opioids and NSAID) or antiinflammatories will affect the inflammation response, thus invalidating the model of endotoxemia and inflammation.
