

Procedure producing pain and/or distress: Irradiation.

Animals may experience lethargy, elevated body temperature, dizziness, disorientation, epilation, seizure, ataxia, purpura, hemorrhaging, bruising, infection, shock, emesis, diarrhea and moribundity.

Analgesia cannot be added to the current studies as the addition would change the lethality in the irradiated portion of the program.
