EXPLANATION FOR THE USE OF ANIMALS LISTED IN COLUMN E

Cattle were infected with *Theileria parva*, the cause of East Coast Fever. *Theileria parva* causes an inflammatory infectious disease, and our experimental design includes options to administer anti-inflammatory drugs (e.g., banamine) to animals that develop fever and other signs of inflammation. The cattle identified as Column E did receive analgesics, and we do everything possible for these animals. However, the analgesics are not able to fully ameliorate fever, so we are reporting the animals in Column E.
