Dear Dr. Westergaard,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your January 24, 2018 letter reporting an adverse event involving a nonhuman primate at Alpha Genesis, Inc. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that a juvenile rhesus monkey died from asphyxiation after becoming entangled in part of a suspended torn sunshade.

The preventive action consisted of removing the damaged sunshade as well as another one so that there are no more on the property. This type of sunshade will no longer be used.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals.

Dear Director,

This self-report describes an accident that occurred on 1/15/2018. The contract number that supported the animal is HHSN272201000051C. The funding component has been notified. The Alpha Genesis, Inc. assurance number is D16-00387 (A3645-01).

A juvenile *Macaca Mulatta* was able to take hold of a piece of material that was a part of a sunshade hung above a hallway adjacent to her enclosure. The monkey somehow became wrapped in the material causing asphyxiation.

As an IACUC approved corrective action for the accident, this torn sunshade and an additional shade located on the property were removed. There are no more shades of this kind on property and they will not be used for future shade structures.
