ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

Two topical medications (vetropolycin (gerbil), mupiricin (canine)), one oral medication (carprofen (canine)) and one injectable medication (lidocaine (equine)) were found to be expired. Two sets of surgical scrub and alcohol in two treatment areas (feline treatment and CPL surgical prep areas) were either not labeled and/or had no expiration dates. Using expired and/or unlabeled medications can cause detrimental effects to the health and well-being of the animals. The use of appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnoses and treat diseases and injuries shall be included in a program of veterinary care.

This inspection was conducted on June 29-30, 2017 and the exit interview was conducted with the facility representative on June 30, 2017.
