## SANITATION.

Wet, matted, heavily soiled litter covered the floors of 4 of 8 enclosures of guinea pigs. The floors of the remaining 4 enclosures had heavy fecal build-up. Wet, soiled litter can result in foot and respiratory infections which compromises the health of the animals. Per this section, primary enclosures shall be cleaned and sanitized often enough to prevent an accumulation of excreta or debris, provided, however, that such enclosures shall be sanitized at least once every 2 weeks in the manner provided in paragraph (a) (4) of this section.
