An exception to the standards and regulations under the Act, involves non-human primate caging. Wall mounted non-human primate caging was used in portable rolling racks in various animal rooms. The cages provide approximately $4.2~\rm ft^2$ of floor space rather than the $4.3~\rm ft^2$ required for non-human primates between 3 to 10 kg. Cage height is $34.6~\rm inches$. The cages slant outward from the bottom and the total volume is greater than $12.0~\rm ft^3$. Height and volume are both above the required 30 inch height and $10.75~\rm ft^3$ volume. The guidelines state that innovative primary enclosures not precisely meeting the floor area and height requirements, but that do provide a sufficient volume of space and opportunity to express species typical behavior may be used when approved by the IACUC. The Animal Care and Use Committee approved the use of the $4.2~\rm ft^2$ floor area, $34.6~\rm inch$ height and $> 12.0~\rm ft^3$ volume cages for animals up to $10~\rm kg$ weight range.
