Dear Dr. Pipher,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your April 6, 2020 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Brown University. This letter had not been preceded by a preliminary report to OLAW.

According to the information provided, this Office understands that the Brown University Animal Care and Use Committee (ACUC) determined that instances of noncompliance occurred with respect to: two mice found dead in a cage. On March 26, 2020 the Center for Animal Resources and Education (CARE) staff found two mice dead within their home cage and it was observed that the cage did not contain any food. The IACUC discussed the incident and determined it was reportable. The following corrective actions were taken:

- The incident was reviewed with all CARE staff.
- The cage change interval was temporarily reduced from once every 10 days to once every 8 days
 while split team staffing is required to address safety and staffing concerns during the COVID-19
 crisis.

It is noted that the final report did not include the funding source involving the incident. In the future, please include the source of funding and provide grant numbers for all PHS or NSF supported work. Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that Brown University has implemented appropriate measures to correct and prevent recurrences of these problems and is now compliant with provisions of the PHS Policy. We appreciate being informed of these matters and find no cause for further action by this Office.

The Brown University Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC), through the Institutional Official (Jill C. Pipher, Ph.D.), is writing to provide OLAW with a final report of the following noncompliance with the *PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* ("PHS Policy"):

On March 26, 2020, the Center for Animal Resources and Education (CARE) staff found 2 mice dead within their home cage. It was observed that the cage did not contain any food.

The IACUC discussed the incident of animal welfare concern related to a PHS funded approved IACUC protocol and determined that it is Animal Care related and reportable under the NIH NOT-OD-05-034, "Guidance on Prompt Reporting to OLAW under the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals."

The following corrective action has taken, or will take, place:

- The incident was reviewed with all CARE staff.
- The cage change interval has been temporarily reduced from once every 10 days to once every 8 days while split team staffing is required to address safety and staffing concerns during the COVID-19 crisis.
