Dear Mr. Hodgson,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your April 16, 2021 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that 110 mouse carcasses were found in the cooler after exposure to CO2 for euthanasia but the required secondary physical method to ensure death had not been performed.

The corrective actions consisted of performing cervical dislocation on the mice. The animal use privileges were revoked for two weeks for the individual responsible. The individual was counseled, retrained on CO2 euthanasia procedures, and competency was assessed by the veterinary staff.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy.

Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP), in accordance with Assurance D16-00280 (A3442-01) and PHS Policy IV.F.3., submits this report of noncompliance regarding the following incident:

On 3/5/2021, a bag of 110 euthanized mice were found in the vivarium's carcass cooler without a secondary method of euthanasia performed. All mice had been euthanized via CO2 and were clinically dead. All animals were subsequently cervically dislocated. It was determined that these mice were assigned to CHOP IACUC protocol 18-001014 Modulation of Hemostasis Using Mouse Models (NIH funded, U54-HL142012)

This incident was discussed at our regularly scheduled monthly IACUC meeting on 3/8/2021. The IACUC voted to revoke access to the animal facilities for a period of two weeks for the individual responsible for this incident, to require that this individual attend a retraining session and proficiency assessment on CO₂ euthanasia and secondary confirmatory euthanasia methods with a Department of Veterinary Resources veterinarian, and to require that this individual meet with the IACUC chair and deputy chairs. The IACUC also voted to report this incident to OLAW with a copy to AAALAC International.

CHOP is committed to quality animal care. We believe that these steps are appropriate to address the noncompliance issue that was identified.
