#### Sanitation.

Indoor rabbit room: There was a buildup of dust on both ceiling vents, on empty cages and on metal shelving directly above the rabbits. There was an accumulation of old animal food/waste, debris on the floor below a bottom shelf of cages and dried, mineralized urine on a lower metal shelf next to a rabbit cage. Plastic sheeting is placed on the floor beneath both cage shelving units in this room. There was an accumulation of both wet and dried urine collecting on the floor underneath this sheeting. Premises including buildings, surrounding grounds and areas housing animals must be kept clean, and in good repair in order to protect and ensure the health and well-being of the animals, and to facilitate the prescribed husbandry practices. A system of maintaining timely and effective housekeeping practices in animal areas must be in place.

Correct by removing animal waste and debris by 07/04/2021 and general room housekeeping by 07/07/2021.
