#### Feeding.

The animal care records documented a lack of sanitization of the feeding containers every 2 weeks. The sanitization of water bottles was documented on 2/5/21, 2/19/21, 4/2/21, 5/14/21, 5/21/21 and 6/4/21. The every two week sanitization was not completed correctly from February 19 to May 21, 2021. At the time of inspection, the feed containers had been sanitized 3 days prior on the correct schedule. Sanitization of water bottles every two weeks is required to minimize disease hazards and ensure the welfare of the guinea pigs.

#### Watering.

The animal care records documented a lack of sanitization of the watering containers every 2 weeks. The sanitization of water bottles was documented on 2/5/21, 2/19/21, 4/2/21, 5/14/21, 5/21/21 and 6/4/21. The every two week sanitization was not completed correctly from February 19 to May 21, 2021. At the time of inspection, the water bottles had been sanitized 3 days prior on the correct schedule. Sanitization of water bottles every two weeks is required to minimize disease hazards and ensure the welfare of the guinea pigs.

#### Sanitation.

The animal care records documented a lack of sanitization of the primary enclosures every 2 weeks. The sanitization of enclosures was documented every two weeks except for between 2 May 21 and 21 May 21, when two weeks should have been 16 May 21. At the time of inspection, the enclosures had been sanitized 4 days prior on the correct schedule. Failure to sanitize surfaces in contact with the animals in a manner provided in Section 3.31(a)(4) may expose the guinea pigs to disease hazards. Facility must ensure that all surfaces in contact with the animals are sanitized at least once every 2 weeks.

This inspection and exit interview were conducted with the Head of Vaccines.
