Not describing appropriate analgesics to be utilized around painful procedures can lead to unmitigated pain and/or distress for the animals. Per the regulation, the IACUC shall determine that the proposed activities meet the following requirements: procedures that may cause more than momentary or slight pain or distress to the animals will be performed with appropriate sedatives, analgesics, or anesthetics.

For IACUC-approved Category D protocols 284, 296, 322 and 334, no delivery of written notice of protocol approval or amendment approval by the IACUC to the principal investigator could be documented. If a proposed activity involving the use of animals begins or is amended without IACUC approval, the animals may be subjected to inappropriate levels of pain and/or distress. Per the regulation, the IACUC shall notify principal investigators in writing of its decision to approve or withhold approval of those activities related to the care and use of animals.

The protocols were approved by the IACUC, despite these procedures' descriptions being inadequate or missing. Approval of proposed protocols lacking complete animal procedure descriptions can lead to serious pain, distress or injury to the animals to be utilized on those protocols. Per the regulation, a proposal to conduct activities involving animals must contain a complete description of the proposed use of the animals.
