Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care.

At the time of inspection, there are several bottles of expired medications comingled with unexpired medications on the pharmacy shelves in the vivarium: One bottle of flunixin meglumine injectable (exp. 08/2021), 11 vials of heparin injectable (exp. 01/2021), and 25 vials of ondansetron injectable (exp. 06/2021). The use of expired medications is not considered to be a safe or appropriate method to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries since the expected results cannot be guaranteed. The animals may experience pain and distress due to unrelieved symptoms or unexpected side effects from the use of expired medications.

The program for providing adequate veterinary care shall include the use of appropriate methods to prevent, control,

diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries. This includes provisions to ensure expired medications are not administered to animals.
