description of any deficiencies and contain a reasonable and specific plan and schedule with dates for correcting each

deficiency.

Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC).

Upon review of the facility's animal use protocol for the immunization of Rabbits for antibody production, there is no description of the approximate number of animals to be used. A rational for involving animals, and for the appropriateness of the species and numbers of animals to be used is not provided. There isn't a complete description of the proposed use of the animals, and there isn't a description of procedures designed to assure that discomfort and pain to animals will be limited to that which, is unavoidable for the conduct of scientifically valuable research.

Each protocol for animal use must contain all aspects of the cited regulation to allow the IACUC to fully understand and adequately review the proposed activities.
