At the time of inspection, there are three bottles of expired medications comingled with unexpired medications on the pharmacy shelves in the vivarium: One vial of 0.5% bupivacaine injectable (exp. 02/01/2022) and two bottles of atropine sulfate ophthalmic solution (exp. 01/2022). The use of expired medications is not considered to be a safe or appropriate method to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries since the expected results cannot be guaranteed. The animals may experience pain and distress due to unrelieved symptoms or unexpected side effects from the use of
