Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care.

At the time of inspection, there are containers of expired medications comingled with unexpired medications on pharmacy shelves:: Two, unopened, 1% atropine sulfate ophthalmic solution packages (both expired 04/2022) and one containing Banamine transdermal pour-on solution (expired 04/2022). In addition to these, there is an opened vial of 5mg/mL diazepam injectable solution (Vial #0929-3, Lot #12-252-EV, Expiration Date 12/01/2021). On 03/29/2022, this vial was used to sedate two, adult female sheep (ID numbers 987506 & 987507, Protocol #08-132) to facilitate transrectal ultrasound examinations, as documented on the controlled substances usage log. All these expired drugs were removed at the time of inspection.

The use of expired medications is not considered to be a safe or appropriate method to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries since the expected results cannot be guaranteed. The animals may experience pain and distress due to unrelieved symptoms or unexpected side effects from the use of expired medications. The program for providing adequate veterinary care shall include the use of appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries. This includes establishing and following procedures to ensure expired medications are not administered to animals.
