Dear Dr. Connor,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your December 23, 2021 letter reporting an adverse incident within the animal care and use program at the University of Wisconsin - Madison's Wisconsin National Primate Research Center. Your letter supplemented the information in the preliminary telephone report on December 22, 2021. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that on December 7, 2021, an adolescent macaque escaped its primary enclosure when the animals living in the enclosure defeated the welds on a feeding door. While out of the enclosure, the animal sustained superficial injuries that required veterinary intervention with a non-steroidal antiinflammatory. The animal recovered. The animal involved was supported by PHS funds.

The enclosure in question has been repaired. The welds on similar enclosures will also be evaluated and repaired, if necessary, to prevent the recurrence of such an incident.

The consideration of this unfortunate incident by the University of Wisconsin - Madison was consistent with the philosophy of institutional self-regulation. Similarly, the actions taken to address the issue and prevent recurrence were appropriate. In the future, please include an estimated timeline for corrective actions, when applicable (repairs, etc.). We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office.

The University of Wisconsin-Madison, in accordance with Assurance A3368-01 and PHS Policy IV.F.3, provides this report of an incident first reported to you via telephone by December 22, 2021.

In this incident, an adolescent macaque exited its primary enclosure when the animals living in the enclosure defeated the welds on a feeding door. While out of the enclosure, the animal sustained superficial injuries that required veterinary intervention with a non-steroidal anti-inflammatory. The animal recovered quickly and the enclosure in question has been repaired. The welds on similar enclosures will also be evaluated and repaired if necessary to prevent the recurrence of such an incident. The animal involved was supported by PHS funds.
