Dear Mr. Smith,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges your January 7, 2022 letter, received in our office on January 21, 2022, reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of California – San Francisco. Your letter supplemented the information contained in the initial telephone report to this Office on June 11, 2021. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that a lab did not administer all post-operative analgesics required by the protocol to mice in March and May of 2021. There were no reports of adverse effects in these animals. This was a PHS-funded study.

Corrective and preventive measures included:

- 1. a protocol modification to update the post-operative analgesia plan.
- 2. the lab completed Post-Approval Survival Surgical Review (PASSR) training.
- 3. each surgeon submitted surgical records for immediate review by IACUC staff, and subsequently submitted surgical records for 3 months.
- 4. all lab members reviewed and confirmed understanding of the relevant protocol.

The laboratory is currently in compliance with UCSF and PHS standards.

OLAW appreciates the prompt consideration of this matter by the University of California – San Francisco, which was consistent with the philosophy of institutional self-regulation. Based on the information provided, OLAW is satisfied that appropriate actions have been taken to correct the deficiency and prevent recurrence. OLAW concurs that the issue warranted reporting. We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office.

#### Dear Dr. Morse,

This letter serves as final follow-up to our preliminary non-compliance report to OLAW on June 11, 2021.

A review of the lab's surgical records for March and May 2021 showed that lab did not administer all post-operative analgesics required by the protocol to mice for an NIH-funded study. At the time of this finding, the post-surgical period had passed and there were no reports of adverse effects in these animals.

#### Follow-up and Corrective Action:

- The PI submitted a protocol modification to update the post-operative analgesia plan that was subsequently approved by the IACUC, including LARC veterinary review.
- The lab completed Post-Approval Survival Surgical Review (PASSR) training with IACUP Staff.
- Each surgeon submitted surgical records for immediate review by IACUP staff, and subsequently submitted surgical records for 3 months.
- All lab members reviewed and confirmed understanding of the relevant protocol.

#### Completion:

As of the date of this letter, corrective actions #1-4 above are complete. The laboratory is currently in compliance with UCSF and PHS standards. I believe the steps taken will help ensure future compliance and prevent reoccurrence. If you have any additional questions, please do not hesitate to contact me or the IACUP Director.
