**III. C**. 8. In addition, the IO (and/or his designee), is provided with the regular (current) monthly IACUC agenda, inspection reports and minutes when it is distributed to IACUC members and liaisons prior to the meeting. If the IACUC encountered a situation where a proposed project involving animals would not be approved, the IO would be contacted directly in writing by the IACUC Chair explaining the situation and rationale of the IACUC's decision.

c) ...Additionally, any lab members that work with biological materials in animals must take EHS 201: Biosafety in Laboratories; and, any individual working in the ABSL2 and/or ABSL3 must receive an in-person training/orientation from a member of the EH&S staff....

## Medical Evaluation and Preventive Medicine for Personnel

a) [4<sup>th</sup> paragraph has been revised] Regardless of the risk(s), all animal users and individuals entered into the new OHSS database will be sent an email inquiry annually asking if there have been any changes in their health and/or are they working with any new species that might change their risk assessment. If the individual answers "yes" to either preceding question, a new (updated) risk assessment must be completed by the PI and the individual in question must update his/her personal health information. However, currently if in two consecutive years there are no changes noted, the individual will no longer receive the annual check-in notice. Therefore, at the time of deNovo review, OACU Analysts confirm with all individuals listed on a protocol that their OHSS information is indeed current and if not, the individual is advised that a new (updated) risk assessment must be completed by the PI and the individual in question must update his/her personal health information in order to remain approved to work with animals under this protocol. OACU Analysts at no time have access to an individual's private health information (PHI) or medical record. If they wish to participate further ....

G. The training or instruction available to scientists, animal technicians, and other personnel involved in animal care, treatment, or use is as follows: [7<sup>th</sup> paragraph]

Finally, as part of the protocol review process, the IACUC may determine that additional training is required to ensure personnel are qualified to perform the procedures proposed. OLAC and OACU jointly update and maintain the training database hosted by OLAC to document ACUC required training as well as elective training and completion dates. The OLAC Trainer maintains a training database to document elective and required procedural training of individuals; PIs must maintain training records of all lab personnel; and, the OACU staff ensure that the basic online CITI training is completed.
