Dear Dr. Nobles,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your March 11, 2022 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the Emory University. This letter had not been preceded by a preliminary report to OLAW.

According to the information provided, this Office understands that the Emory University Animal Care and Use Committee (ACUC) determined that instances of noncompliance occurred with respect to: failure to adhere to the IACUC-approved protocol. The final report states on August 24, 2021, it was determined that monitoring of animals and surgical records were not being completed as described in the protocol. In response to the incident, the following corrective actions were implemented:

- A PAM was completed on November 15, 2021 and consisted of coaching the lab on appropriate completion of post-op monitoring as stated in the approved protocol, and appropriate completion of surgery logs.
- A follow-up from the lab to the IACUC office on December 5, 2021 produced accurate surgery and monitoring records.

The IACUC determined the corrective actions were appropriate to prevent a similar occurrence regarding this NIH-supported research. Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that the Emory University has implemented appropriate measures to correct and prevent recurrences of these problems and is now compliant with provisions of the PHS Policy.

We appreciate being informed of these matters and find no cause for further action by this Office.

The Emory University Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC), through the Institutional Official, is reporting the results of an event as required by section IV, F, 3a of the Public Health Service Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals (PHS Policy). A preliminary report was provided via phone call to your office on 2/1/22. This is the final report regarding a protocol violation of incomplete monitoring checks and incomplete surgical records. The associated NIH-funded grants are K12HD072245 and F42371-00.

Situation and Assessment

On August 24, 2021, it was determined that monitoring and surgical records were not being completed as per the approved protocol.

The corrective actions taken to prevent a recurrence were:

- A PAM was requested for the lab and the principal investigator and was completed on 11/15/2021. The PAM consisted of coaching the lab on correctly completing post-op monitoring as stated in the approved protocol, and correctly completing surgery logs.
- A follow-up from the lab to the IACUC office on 12/5/2021 produced accurate surgery and monitoring records.
