Dear Dr. Yates,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your June 29, 2021 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Pittsburgh. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that mice were given tamoxifen in drinking water for six months although this activity had not been approved by the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC).

The corrective actions consisted of keeping an electronic version of the protocol to allow access by laboratory staff, issuing a letter of reprimand to the investigator and supervisor, ensuring that the grant was not charged for any unauthorized animal activities, and informing the investigator about the ramifications of using unapproved data in publications/presentations.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the IACUC to comply with the PHS Policy.

Dear Dr. Morse:

As the Institutional Official responsible for the University of Pittsburgh's Animal Care and Use Program (Assurance number D16-00118), I am writing to advise your office of a reportable incident<sup>1</sup>.

For a six-month period, mice assigned to an investigator's protocol were treated with tamoxifen in their drinking water, although the use of this drug was not described in the approved protocol.

The IACUC accepted the investigator's corrective action plan (CAP), which consisted of the following items:

1. The investigator will maintain a current version of the protocol in an online folder so that all lab personnel can access it to ensure that all procedures to be performed have been approved by the IACUC.

The investigator's research is funded by the following NIH grant:

5-R01-AI148356-02 IL-17 regulates LN stromal cell metabolism and function

The IACUC levied the following sanctions

- 1. A letter of reprimand was sent to the investigator, and his/her supervisor regarding this event. This letter has been placed in our files.
- 2. The investigator was reminded that studies involving off-protocol work cannot be paid for with NIH funds. Such charges will be removed.

3. The investigator was reminded that data collected from studies involving offprotocol work represents work not approved by the IACUC and cannot be used in public presentations or publications without disclosing the lack of IACUC approval.
