- Nonscientist (NS) – a member whose primary concerns are in non-scientific areas (e.g. ethicist, lawyer, member of clergy).
- Non-affiliated (NA) – a member who is not affiliated with the Institution in any way other than as a member of the IACUC, and who is not a member of the immediate family of a person who is affiliated. This member is expected to represent the interests of the general community in the proper care and use of animals and should not be a laboratory animal user. A consulting attending veterinarian may not be considered non-affiliated.

NOTES:

1. All members must be appointed by the CEO (or individual with specific written delegation to appoint members) and must be voting members. Ad hoc or nonvoting members may be listed and identified as such but are not considered members for the purpose of the PHS Policy, and do not contribute to a quorum.
2. If Alternates members are listed, identify for whom (by name or code number, not specialty) they will serve as Alternates.
