Dear Ms. Mellouk,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your July 13, 2021 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Boston University, following up on an initial telephone report on July 8, 2021. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that 30 mice were identified with tumors and that the animals were being manipulated in a laboratory although neither the tumor work nor the performance site had been approved by the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC).

The corrective actions consisted of returning the mice to the vivarium, counseling the Principal Investigator on the content of the protocol, transferring the tumor mice to a holding protocol, having the IACUC approve a protocol amendment, and subsequently transferring the mice to the amended protocol.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the IACUC to comply with the PHS Policy.

Boston University, in accordance with Assurance D16-00204 (A3316-01) and PHS Policy IV.F.3., provides this final report of serious noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals. A preliminary report of this incident was provided to OLAW via voicemail on 7/8/21.

On 6/16/21, the veterinarian visited the lab to request return of six cages of mice that had been removed from the vivarium. Thirty mice were observed undergoing tumor measurement with calipers. Transport to the lab and tumor studies were not in the approved protocol.

The IACUC discussed the incident at its July 6, 2021 meeting. The Committee accepted the following corrective and preventive actions:

- The veterinarian required that all cages be returned to the vivarium.
- On 6/16/21, the PAM Program Manager discussed with the PI that the location and tumor work were not approved in the protocol. Tumor work is described in a different protocol for which animals were on the holding protocol pending approval of an amendment.
- The tumor-bearing animals were transferred to the holding protocol until approval of the amendment. The amendment was approved and animals transferred to the appropriate protocol on 6/29/21.
