Dear Dr. Burg,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your May 2, 2022 letter reporting a serious deviation from the provisions of the *Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* at the University of Georgia, following up on an initial report on March 25, 2022. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that a mouse cage, containing one mouse, was not returned to the rack overnight by the laboratory staffer which prevented the animal from accessing water from the lixit. The mouse was checked the next day and found to be alert and active.

The corrective actions consisted of the veterinarian counseling the laboratory staff on double checking the procedure room to ensure that all cages are returned to the rack when activities are completed. The Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) sent a reminder letter to the Principal Investigator to ensure that staff uses care when handling the mouse cages.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the IACUC to comply with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals.

Dear Dr Morse,

I am writing to provide a final report of a serious deviation from the PHS Policy that was identified on March 23, 2022 and initially reported to OLAW on date March 25, via email. A researcher inadvertently left a mouse cage off of an IVC rack overnight. Because the cage's water source was the rack lixit, the cage had no water supply from approximately 3pm on 3/22 to 9am on 3/23. The cage contained only 1 mouse, and only the 1 mouse was affected. The mouse appeared bright, alert, and responsive when the cage was discovered off of the rack by the animal care staff the next morning.

This work is covered by an IACUC approved protocol and funded by the NIH under grant number RO1 AA026362.

The laboratory animal veterinarian contacted the lab personnel, and the lab personnel reviewed the procedure for double checking a room when tasks are completed, before leaving the room, to avoid this type of mistake.

At its scheduled meeting on April 20, the IACUC discussed the matter, and determined that the response to the incident had been appropriate and no further action was required. The IACUC chose to send a letter to the PI, reminding them to ensure the research personnel are careful when handling mouse cages.

The University of Georgia is committed to a high-quality animal care and use program and the welfare of animals used in instruction and research. We take very seriously our institutional responsibility for the evaluation, monitoring, reporting, and correction of our animal care and use program that is the foundation of the PHS Policy. Please contact me if further information or additional corrective actions are needed.
