The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your November 1, 2021 final letter reporting an instance of noncompliance at the University of Iowa. OLAW understands that on September 8, 2021, following blood collection on pigs, the laboratory identified that the route of blood collection used was approved on one but not the other Animal Protocol. The lab had inadvertently ordered and used the two animals under the incorrect Animal Protocol. The Principal Investigator (PI) self-reported the incident to the veterinary staff who promptly notified the IACUC office. This project was funded by PHS.

As a corrective measure, the Senior Compliance and Education specialist spoke to the PI and instructed the PI to stress to all laboratory members the importance of verifying that the animals are under the correct protocol prior to initiating procedures.

OLAW appreciates the prompt consideration of this matter by the University of Iowa which is consistent with the philosophy of institutional self-regulation. OLAW assumes that there were no adverse health implications on the animals due to the non-compliance as there was none described in your submitted report. Please update this Office if adverse health conditions impacted the animals due to this non-compliance incident. OLAW expects continuing post-approval monitoring to prevent recurrence of this non-compliance and potential associated animal welfare concerns. Based on the information provided, OLAW is satisfied that appropriate steps have been taken to investigate this incident and to attempt to prevent recurrence.

September 8, 2021: Following blood collection, the lab identified that the route used was approved on one but not their other Animal Protocol. The lab had inadvertently ordered and used the two animals under the incorrect Animal Protocol. The PI self-reported the incident to the veterinary staff who promptly notified the IACUC Office.

The Senior Compliance and Education Specialist spoke with the PI and instructed him/her to stress to all lab members the importance of verifying the animals are under the correct Animal Protocol prior to initiating procedures.

October 13, 2021: The IACUC members discussed the incident at a convened meeting and voted to report to the appropriate agencies.
