Dear Ms. Lassner,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your December 20, 2021 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals within the animal care and use program at the University of Iowa. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that a laboratory member performed surgery that was not as described in the approved protocol. Additionally, supplemental hydration was not provided as supportive care as was described in the protocol. One mouse was found dead the day after surgery and the lab elected to euthanize the remaining mice due to concerns for their health and wellbeing. The mice involved in this incident were supported by NIH funding.

Corrective and preventive measures included counseling and retraining of the responsible laboratory staff. In addition, veterinary staff observed the responsible laboratory member performing the surgery to ensure compliance with the protocol and competency in the procedure.

OLAW appreciates the consideration of this matter by the University of Iowa which was consistent with the philosophy of institutional self-regulation. Based on the information provided, OLAW is satisfied that appropriate actions have been taken to investigate this incident and prevent recurrence. However, in future reports, please include the approximate number of animals involved.

We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office.

This letter is to report an incident involving mice. The University of Iowa PHS Assurance Number is D16-00009 (A3021-01). The grant number affected is GM115424.

November 8, 2021: A lab member performed a surgery that was not in accordance with its description in the approved Animal Protocol. Additionally, one element of supportive care outlined in the Animal Protocol was not followed (i.e., supplemental hydration). One mouse was found dead in the cage the following day. The lab elected to euthanize the remaining mice on the 10th due to concerns for the health and wellbeing of the animals and contacted the veterinarian for assistance.

The IACUC Office was promptly notified. The Senior Compliance and Education Specialist (SCES) and veterinarian met with the PI and lab member to discuss the incident and retraining was provided. Additionally, the veterinary staff observed the lab member performing the surgery to ensure compliance with the protocol and competency in the procedure.

December 8, 2021: The IACUC members discussed the incident at a convened meeting and voted to report to the appropriate agencies.
