The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your January 24, 2022 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Iowa. This letter had not been preceded by a preliminary report to OLAW.

According to the information provided, this Office understands that the University of Iowa Animal Care and Use Committee (ACUC) determined that instances of noncompliance occurred with respect to: failure to adhere to institutional policies/procedures. The final report states a mouse was found dead on December 15, 2021. It was determined an animal care technician did not adhere to the established procedures for clinical cases. As a result, the veterinary technician was not able to evaluate the animal in a timely manner.

In response to the incident, the technician was properly retrained and the IACUC voted to report the incident to appropriate agencies. It is noted that the final report did not include the funding source involving the incident. In the future, please include the source of funding and provide grant numbers for all PHS, NSF or NASA supported work.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that the University of Iowa has implemented appropriate measures to correct and prevent recurrences of these problems and is now compliant with provisions of the PHS Policy.

We appreciate being informed of these matters and find no cause for further action by this Office.

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your January 24, 2022 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Iowa. This letter had not been preceded by a preliminary report to OLAW.

According to the information provided, this Office understands that the University of Iowa Animal Care and Use Committee (ACUC) determined that instances of noncompliance occurred with respect to: the conduct of animal activities prior to IACUC review and approval. The final report states on January 6, 2022, a laboratory self-reported that they conducted an unapproved surgical procedure on six mice. It is stated the procedure and post-procedural management was approved in rats (and not mice) in the protocol. The animals were evaluated by veterinary staff and one mouse required euthanasia due to health concerns. It is understood the Principal Investigator agreed that no data from these animals would be used for publication or grant proposals.

In response to the incident, the lab members were retrained, and an amendment was filed to the protocol. The IACUC members discussed the matter on January 12, 2022 and voted to report to the appropriate agencies. It is noted this research is supported by applicable funding with OLAW oversight.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that the University of Iowa has implemented appropriate measures to correct and prevent recurrences of these problems and is now compliant with provisions of the PHS Policy.

We appreciate being informed of these matters and find no cause for further action by this Office.

This letter is to report an incident involving a mouse. The University of Iowa PHS Assurance Number is D16-00009 (A3021-01).

December 15, 2021: A mouse was found dead in the cage. Upon review of the case it was found that an animal care technician did not follow the established procedures for clinical cases (medical records SOP). This resulted in a veterinary technician not evaluating the animal in a timely manner.

The IACUC Office was promptly notified. The animal care technician was properly retrained.

January 12, 2022: The IACUC members discussed the incident at a convened meeting and voted to report to the appropriate agencies.
