The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your November 10, 2021, letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Iowa. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that a lab member performed unauthorized post-wean tail snip procedures for genotyping on three mice without prior IACUC approval. There were no animal welfare issues as a result of the noncompliance and the associated animal activity was supported by PHS funds.

The corrective actions consisted of retraining the laboratory personnel and amending the Animal Protocol.

Based on the information provided, OLAW is satisfied that appropriate actions have been taken to investigate, correct and prevent recurrence of the noncompliance. We appreciate having been informed about this matter and find no cause for further action by this Office.

This letter is to report an incident involving mice. The University of Iowa PHS Assurance Number is D16-00009 (A3021-01). The grant number affected is DK110023.

October 14, 2021: A lab member improperly performed post-wean tail snip for genotyping in three mice. Mice were observed to be in good health following veterinary observation. The technique was not approved in the Animal Protocol.

The IACUC Office was promptly notified. Lab retraining occurred and proper amendments to the Animal Protocol were made.

November 10, 2021: The IACUC members discussed the incident at a convened meeting and voted to report to the appropriate agencies.


