The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your April 15, 2022 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Iowa. This letter had not been preceded by a preliminary report to OLAW.

According to the information provided, this Office understands that the University of Iowa Animal Care and Use Committee (ACUC) determined that instances of noncompliance occurred with respect to: the conduct of animal activities without prior IACUC review and approval and failure to adhere to institutional policies/procedures. The final report states on March 16, 2022, it was discovered that a laboratory performed post-wean tail snipping on 3 adult mice and did not provide analgesia. This procedure was not approved on the protocol nor was it performed in accordance with the IACUC policy on Rodent Tail Snipping for Genotyping. It is stated the animals appeared to be in good health and the IACUC Office was informed of the incident. The corrective action involved retraining of the Principal Investigator and the lab member. Also, an amendment was submitted and approved to add the technique. The IACUC reviewed the matter and determined it to be reportable to appropriate agencies.

It is noted that these animals are supported by PHS funding. Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that the University of Iowa has implemented appropriate measures to correct and prevent recurrences of these problems and is now compliant with provisions of the PHS Policy.

We appreciate being informed of these matters and find no cause for further action by this Office.

This letter is to report an incident involving mice. The University of Iowa PHS Assurance Number is D16-00009 (A3021-01). The grant number affected is HL130346.

March 16, 2022: A lab was found to have performed post-wean tail snip in three adult mice with no analgesia provided. This was not approved in their Animal Protocol nor in accordance with the IACUC Policy on Rodent Tail Snipping for Genotyping. The mice appeared in good health.

The IACUC Office was promptly notified. The PI and lab member were retrained. An amendment was submitted and approved for the technique.

April 13, 2022: The IACUC members discussed the incident at a convened meeting and voted to report to the appropriate agencies.
