The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your December 9, 2021 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Colorado - Denver. This letter had not been preceded by a preliminary report to OLAW.

According to the information provided, this Office understands that the University of Colorado - Denver Animal Care and Use Committee (ACUC) determined that instances of noncompliance occurred with respect to: unintended breeding on a protocol. The final report states a male mouse was inadvertently housed with female mice for transfer of animals from one lab to another. As a result, three females gave birth to pups and breeding is not approved on either protocol.

In response to the incident, the primary investigator counseled the laboratory members, and the staff member was retrained. Also, the lab has implemented a secondary verification as a standard process. It is understood a quorum of the IACUC accepted the corrective actions taken regarding the matter.

It is noted this research is supported by PHS funding. Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that the University of Colorado - Denver has implemented appropriate measures to correct and prevent recurrences of these problems and is now compliant with provisions of the PHS Policy.

We appreciate being informed of these matters and find no cause for further action by this Office.

The Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) at the University of Colorado Denver | Anschutz Medical Campus received a report of a non-compliance. Specifically, a male mouse was inadvertently housed with female mice as part of a transfer of animals from one lab to another. As a result, three out of the four females gave birth to pups. Breeding is not approved on either protocol.

The Primary Investigator counselled the lab members and the staff member was re-trained. In addition, the laboratory has now included a secondary verification as a standard process.

At a convened meeting of a quorum of the IACUC, a majority of the quorum present determined to accept the actions as taken. The Committee determined further that the Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) be informed of this incident (NIH Grant #1R01CA229259-01).
