Evaluation of the Animal Care and Use Program

The IACUC conducted its semiannual evaluation of Loyola University Chicago's Animal Care and Use Program on **April 15, 2020** using the *Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* (Guide, Eight Edition), and, as applicable, 9 CFR Chapter I, 2.31.

The following deficiencies were found in the animal care and use program:
