Dear Dr. Cunningham,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your June 8, 2022 letter reporting a deviation from the provisions of the *Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* at Wayne State University, following up on an initial report on January 12, 2022. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that the daily health check was not conducted for one weekend day in a mouse satellite facility. The individual responsible was filling in during the pandemic staff shortage and was not familiar with the building. No adverse animal impacts occurred due to the missed room check.

The corrective actions consisted of posting weekend staff instructions in a designated location to ensure that husbandry staff knows which tasks to complete.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals.

RE: Report of Minor Non-compliance

#### Dear Dr. Morse:

I am writing to inform you of an incident of minor non-compliance. The Division of Laboratory Animal Resources (DLAR) at Wayne State University (WSU) failed to follow WSU policy and Federal regulations which led to a reportable deviation from the provisions of the *Guide* with respect to the proper care and use of animals in research.

#### Incident:

On Sunday January 2, 2022 DLAR employees failed to perform a daily check on a satellite room outside of the vivarium proper that contained 40 mice. Subsequent observation on the following day revealed an absence of adverse outcomes associated with the failure.

### Attending Veterinarian (AV) Response:

Investigation of the incident revealed that a staff member that was unfamiliar with the building performed duties that day due to staff shortages related to the COVID-19 pandemic. The AV added that DLAR staff will be reminded to place the weekend directions for staff in a designated location so that any DLAR staff member can find the sheet and perform weekend duties in a proper manner.

### **IACUC Finding:**

During a convened meeting on January 26, 2022, the IACUC voted that the incident constitutes minor non-compliance and to accepted the AV's corrective actions, but felt that the incident should none-the-less be reported.

On Sunday 1/2/2022, DLAR employees failed to perform a daily room check on animals that were being housed in an IACUC approved satellite room outside of the vivarium proper. Subsequent observation on the following day revealed an absence of adverse outcomes associated with the failure to observe on 1/2/2022. Investigation of the incident revealed that a staff member that was unfamiliar with the building performed duties that day due to staff shortages related to the COVID-19 pandemic. DLAR staff will be reminded to place the weekend directions for staff in a predictable location so that any DLAR staff member can find the sheet and perform weekend duties in a proper manner.

This item will be discussed with the IACUC at the next meeting on 1/26/21 and a formal and final report from the IO will follow.
