Dear Dr. Russell,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your August 27, 2021 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals within the animal care and use program at the University of Texas – Southwestern Medical Center. Your letter supplements the information in the preliminary telephone report to our office on July 1, 2021. According to the information supplied, OLAW understands that on June 14, 2021 a research staff member did not administer the protocol-required analgesic regimen to three cages of post-operative mice. The protocol requires the administration of both an opioid and an NSAID; however, only an NSAID was provided to these animals. This incident involved animals that were supported by funding from the PHS.

Corrective and preventive actions included the research staff member and the PI being counseled by a Sr. IACUC liaison and by an IACUC Manager. The research staff member and Pl agreed to administer analgesia per the approved protocol. As of August 23, 2021, no further issues have been observed.

The prompt consideration of this matter by the University of Texas – Southwestern Medical Center was consistent with the philosophy of institutional self-regulation and self-correction. We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office.

Dear Dr. Morse,

I write to provide a final report of non-compliance with the *PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* regarding an incident on June 14, 2021. The IACUC determined that a research staff member did not administer the approved analgesic regimen to three cages of post-operative mice. The approved protocol describes the administration of both an opioid and an NSAID; however, only an NSAID was provided to these animals. This determination was based on observations made by clinical veterinary staff. The incident was first reported to you on June 25, 2021 via a voicemail message from an IACUC Manager.

The research staff member and PI were counseled on June 15, 2021 and June 16, 2021 by a Sr. IACUC Liaison, and on June 23, 2021 by an IACUC Manager. The research staff member and PI agreed to administer analgesia per the approved protocol. As of August 23, 2021, no further issues have been observed.

We believe the actions taken by the IACUC are appropriate for this situation.
