The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your December 6, 2021 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals within the animal care and use program at the University of Texas – Southwestern Medical Center. Your letter supplements the information in the preliminary telephone report to our office on November 16, 2021. According to the information supplied, OLAW understands that on November 9, 2021 it was determined that a research staff member performed unapproved tail snipping procedures on about 45 mice for genotyping purposes. The animals were assigned to PHS-supported activities.

Corrective and preventive measures: the research staff member and PI were counseled by a Senior IACUC Liaison and ceased the unapproved work. Subsequently the PI submitted amendments to two protocols to describe the tail snipping of mice for genotyping. Both amendments were approved by the IACUC.

The prompt consideration of this matter by the University of Texas – Southwestern Medical Center was consistent with the philosophy of institutional self-regulation and self-correction. We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office.

Dear Dr. Morse,

I write to provide a final report of non-compliance with the *PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals* regarding an incident on November 9, 2021. The IACUC determined that a research staff member performed unapproved tail snipping procedures on about 45 mice for genotyping purposes. This determination was based on observations made by clinical veterinary staff and was first reported to you on November 16, 2021 via voicemail message from an IACUC Manager.

The research staff member and PI were counseled on November 9, 2021 by a Sr. IACUC Liaison and agreed to cease the unapproved work. Subsequently on November 9, 2021, the PI submitted amendments to two protocols to describe the tail snipping of mice for genotyping. Both amendments were approved by the IACUC on November 18, 2021.

We believe the actions taken by the IACUC are appropriate for this situation.
