Meeting was brought to order at 1:00 PM and quorum confirmed with 9 of 16 members present.

# **Introductions:**

- New members
  - New IACUC members were introduced and welcomed.

#### **Standing Items:**

- Approve minutes of previous meetings.
  - The June 2021 minutes were approved as written.
- Submission Metrics
  - The IACUC AD presented submission metrics. Of note:
    - Total submissions and approvals continue on an upward trend and have increased in comparison to pre-COVID work

#### **Announcements:**

- New member training:
  - Members were informed that new member training and refresher training will be held Friday, July 16,
    2021. Of note:
    - Training will last roughly 2 hours.
    - A packet will be sent out prior to training with additional information.
    - Reminded members that IACUC membership and business is confidential and must remain confidential.
    - Post-doctorate individuals are allowed to join the IACUC and training as long as their PI and/or department head approves.

#### **New Business:**

- National NHP Shortage:
  - Veterinarian discussed NHP shortage with committee. Of note:
    - Protocol work is slowing as there is a nationwide NHP availability shortage due to COVID and other factors.
    - NHP are limited and only being allocated by a central committee.

 PI's working with NHP may be submitting amendments to continue research with limited animals thus Committee members need to be aware of the resource shortage and examine amendments accordingly.

# - 18-384 Welfare Report

- The Committee discussed an incident involving an anonymous welfare report. Of note:
  - Alleges that electrodes implanted are not properly sterilized.
  - Veterinarian observed animals in facility and noted no ongoing issues related to non-sterile equipment.
  - Animals that had recovered two weeks did not show any signs of infection.
  - Discussed incident with PI and recommend protocol assessment to determine if any amendments need to be made. PI agreed and is willing to assist with recommendations.
  - Preliminary findings indicate that there are no animal welfare concerns, rather complaint may stem from personal/political matters.
- o The IACUC did not vote as the non-compliance process is still in progress.

# eSirius help text(s) & info.

- The Committee discussed updating the help text in eSirius. As of note:
  - The current version of edited help text can be found in Box.
  - Members were asked for input on what they would find useful in the methodology help text. Of note:
    - Adding hyperlinks to different information dependent on methodology type (e.g.: Rodents, USDA, etc.)
    - Committee members need to provide feedback by the end of the week.
    - Committee needs to relay frustrations/complaints to Chair, AV, and/or Sr. Director Research, Ethics and Quality.
