Old Business

- 20-617*
 - The committee discussed the implemented updates. Of note:
 - Bats are fed with live mealworms and a mealworm slurry for 48 hours. If animals are not doing
 well, i.e. not eating on their own, animals are re-released at dusk and in same capture location.
 - Based on VET monitoring, animals are evaluated on the 2nd day after capture, and are found to be doing well.
 - Most recent capture consisted of 20 animals captured and 10 of them released due to not eating desired amount.

Member Training:

- Inspections Q&A
 - Members were thanked for performing inspections
 - Tips were proved to members. Of note:
 - Fall inspections are mostly held in-person.
 - Inspectors were advised to coordinate a day and time that works best for them. Once details have been established, the inspectors should contact the PI and PI contacts and let them know that the inspection will be performed at the predetermined date and time.
 - Contact list provided outlines the PI's and Contacts contact information. If there are no primary contacts listed for the PI, the PI will be the main contact.
 - Already completed inspections showed that labs are generally in good condition.
