Section I B. This institution's program for animal care and use has changed

- Emory University currently has one NASA funded research projects. This project does not involve use of the International Space Station.
- IACUC Operations: The IACUC is conducting the scheduled IACUC Full Committee meetings and training (new members and refreshers for site inspection and/or program reviews) by telecommunications via Zoom.
- Site inspections conducted between October 1, 2021, and May 30, 2022, were conducted using the Zoom platform, except for inspections at the Emory Primate Center which were conducted always in-person. In-person site inspections resumed on June 1, 2022.
- The business name for the Yerkes National Primate Research Center was changed to Emory National Primate Research Center.

- Organizational changes
 - As of November 2021, the Office of Research Administration re-structured its compliance arm by creating the Research Compliance and Regulatory Affairs Department which includes the IACUC Office, this Department is led by (b) (6). The IACUC director reports to the AVP for RCRA. The AVP for RCRA report to the Vice President for Research Administration and IO, Dr. Robert Nobles.
