New Animal Care Mission Continuity Steering Committee: The Animal Care Mission Continuity Steering Committee functions in an advisory role to support and advance the continuity planning efforts of the Animal Care Program. The committee formed in August 2019 and meets quarterly to provide guidance and input on the development, implementation, and evaluation of the Animal Care Program; prioritize the development of continuity plans; and identify department essential functions critical to the campus research and teaching mission.

IACUC Policy Review and Policy Subcommittees: The IACUC Policy Review Subcommittee has revised their policy review schedule and practices. A rotating block of policies will now be reviewed annually over three years, thus ensuring each policy is reviewed at least once every three years on a fixed annual schedule. Any changes made to policies prior to the three-year review will be documented as a new version. (Note: due to the COVID Pandemic response this schedule has been modified to allow approximate three-year review.

The Post-Approval Monitoring Policy was modified to incorporate a wider range of activities that constitute post-approval monitoring.

An Agricultural Animals and Analgesics Subcommittee was formed and charged with drafting a new policy focusing on the requirements and use of analgesics in agricultural animals.

USDA Site Addition: UC Davis had historically been considered one USDA site, inspected under a single USDA registration. In April 2019, the USDA approved the California National Primate Research Center to be its own site, separate site from the UC Davis main campus. Both sites remain under the original USDA registration, however they are now inspected separately.

Facility and Space Updates: Space decommissioned: Owls have been relocated to newly refurbished space within an existing vivarium. The previous owl housing area is currently decommissioned. Grazing land removed: Our 2018 annual report identified a new offsite facility in Maxwell CA used for periodic cattle grazing. UC Davis no longer uses this privately owned land.

Over the last year, we have continued to refine how we account for buildings and square footage within our Animal Care Program. These refined numbers reflect information obtained through updated technology and more accurately capture the size and scope of our program. It should be noted the UC Davis Animal Care Program footprint has not increased as might be implied with the updated numbers.
