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

#### PROGRAM CHANGES:

## I. Institutional Program for Animal Care and Use

A. The lines of authority and responsibility for administering the program and ensuring compliance with the PHS Policy are as follows:



The IACUC will:

- 9) Conduct continuing review of each previously approved, ongoing activity covered by PHS Policy at appropriate intervals as determined by the IACUC, including a complete review at least once every 3 years according to PHS Policy IV.C.1.-5. The IACUC procedures for conducting continuing reviews are as follows:
  - a. <u>Annual Review of Approved Protocols</u>. The IACUC is conducting annual reviews for protocols that cover client-owned animals, wildlife, or are DoD funded. This review requires that PIs submit information about personnel changes, the number of animals used, the health status of animals, and about unexpected complications or difficulties that may have occurred during the previous 12month period of approval. About a month before the anniversary of each protocol (excluding those protocols that are scheduled for more extensive triennial resubmission and review), the PI will be notified that the Annual Continuation Form must be completed using the Coeus electronic system. The review process for Annuals is the same as for new protocols described above.
