Dear Dr. Connor,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your September 23, 2022 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Wisconsin- Madison, following up on an initial telephone report on August 31, 2022. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that laboratory staff performed 29 blood collections on three macaques although the protocol was only approved for 20. No adverse effects were reported in the animals due to the extra blood draws.

The corrective action consisted of amending the protocol to allow additional blood draws and counseling the Principal Investigator and staff to follow the protocol as approved.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy. If not already in place, OLAW encourages the institution to consider use of Veterinary Verification and Consultation to address such situations. Thank you for keeping OLAW apprised on this matter.

The University of Wisconsin-Madison, in accordance with Assurance A3368-01 and PHS Policy IV.F.3, provides this report of an incident first reported to you via telephone by Dr. Janet Welter on August 31, 2022.

In this incident, during a protocol audit it was found that lab staff performed 29 blood sample collections on 3 macaques that were on a protocol that only allowed for 20 blood sample collections per animal. No adverse outcomes resulted from the additional blood sampling. The protocol has since been amended to allow for additional blood sampling. The PI and lab staff have been reminded to review their protocols frequently to assure compliance. The animals involved were supported by PHS funds.

The LSVC ACUC discussed this incident in full committee and determined that the corrective steps taken were appropriate. If you have further questions, please feel free to contact either of us or Dr. Janet Welter.
