

Addendum to Annual Report: September 30, 2021-October 31, 2022

Mixed species housing: University of Vermont has one large animal housing facility for biomedical research and (b) (7)(F). There may be times when pigs and sheep will be housed in the same room at once with the rationale that their housing and care needs are similar, and they are separated by sufficient space to avoid cross-contamination. Animals of different health status are handled in a clean to dirty order. Number of animals affected = 87

(b) (4): Use of expired medical materials for non-survival procedures. Expired materials may only be used in terminal procedures and must be stored away from other non-expired materials. Number of animals affected = 87

(b) (4); Animals used for acute, terminal studies will have a shorter acclimation period (40 hours) between arrival and acute procedure. (b) (4)

The experiments will not be affected by physiologic responses the animals may have due to travel or housing. Number of animals affected = 75.
