Exception Report

Exception to the regulatory requirement under 9 C.F.R. 2.31(d)(1)(x)

- Common name and/or species name: Two common marmosets (Callibrix jaccbus)
- What the exception is: Approval for use of an animal in more than one major operative procedure from which it is allowed to recover on more than one protocol. The IACUC approved this exception on September 22, 2021 and USDA/APHIS-Animal Care approval was granted November 1, 2021. An additional exception to 9 C.F.R. 2.31(d)(1)(x), involving one of the two animals indicated above, was approved by the IACUC on February 23, 2022 and USDA/APHIS-Animal Care approval was granted March 9, 2022.
- Why the exception was required: Exception approved by USDA/APHIS-Animal Care on November 1, 2021- To continue work that was not completed prior to expiration of the original protocol. Exception approved by USDA/APHIS- Animal Care on March 9, 2022- Due to extenuating circumstances, an additional major operative procedure may be required.
