Dear Dr. Yates.

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your August 11, 2023, letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory at the University of Pittsburgh. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that three head-fixed mice on a PHS-supported study were left overnight in a behavioral chamber without access to food and water. The animals were ambulatory and recovered after they were returned to their home cage and provided DietGel.

The corrective action consisted of submitting a letter describing the noncompliance to the investigator and supervisor and the IACUC approving the investigator's action plan instructing laboratory personnel to set reminders during every study to take animals out of the behavioral apparatus.

The establishment and application of policies and practices that are consistent with the provisions of the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at the University of Pittsburgh are commendable and avoid the perception of a double standard. We appreciate having been informed about this matter and find no cause for further action by this Office.

Dear Dr. Morse:

As the Institutional Official responsible for the University of Pittsburgh's Animal Care and Use Program (Assurance number D16-00118), I am writing to advise your office of a reportable incident¹.

On June 8, 2023, three head-fixed mice were found unattended and without access to food and water. They had been left in a behavioral chamber overnight. Upon discovery, the mice were returned to their home cages and provided with DietGel. Afterward, the mice were ambulatory, and recovered.

The IACUC approved the corrective action plan submitted by the investigator for the incident, which included the following item:

• The investigator instructed lab personnel to set reminders during every experiment to take animals out of the behavioral apparatus.
