III. Report by the Attending Veterinarian

- The AV presented the following Adverse Events that were received in February
 - ASAF 6506: This is a protocol that involves perfusion of a tracer under anesthesia to investigate toxicity in fish. The group performed perfusions as normal on six fish using the Evan's Blue Dye tracer both alone and in combination with another tracer and all fish went into cardiac arrest before the procedure was completed. The fish were under anesthesia when this occurred so there were no animal welfare concerns, but the research group is looking into alternative options to Evan's Blue Dye. An amendment has been recently submitted for the protocol to update the adverse events section and to add alternative tracers.
- The AV presented the list of VVCs approved in February. There were no questions from the committee.
- The AV updated the committee on the following items:
 - ASAF 6686: This protocol uses laboratory mice to investigate the anti-tumoral properties of a photodynamic compound that is expected to destroy tumorous cells upon focal exposure to a laser beam. Previously, <u>a group of a group of</u> five mice became lethargic after treatment, and were subsequently euthanized. <u>More recently</u>, <u>Aa</u>nother group of mice was <u>more recently</u> treated_with a lower dose of the photodynamic compound and shorter duration of laser exposure and <u>all</u> recovered. <u>They did experience minor lameness that was treated with-with</u>

analgesic <u>drugs.</u>treatment after experiencing minor lameness. The mice from the first group were submitted for necropsy <u>and the results from the</u>, for which the histology tests are is still pending.

- ASAF 6816: This is a bone implant study <u>using in rats, that which had previously had experienced a fewsome</u> adverse events <u>involving involving</u> unexpected bone fractures. A new experimental group underwent the surgery using the <u>a</u> revised implant size and reached the planned experimental endpoints. <u>The animals</u> <u>successfully reached the planned study endpoint without any No-complications (including or fractures) occurred, and.</u> <u>rR</u>adiographs confirmed proper implant placement.
- ASAF 6082: This is a protocol that uses pine siskins to study bird migration cues and behaviors. A group of nine wild-caught birds were found dead or had to berequired euthanasia euthanized shortly after being brought back to the housing facility at WSU. A necropsy of one of the deceased birds revealed a salmonella infection. Wild pine siskins have recently experienced a population eirruption and an outbreak of salmonella was noted in them this species by Fish and Wildlife. The group plans to coordinate with Fish and Wildlife and more closely examine wild-caught birds prior to bringing them to WSU in the future.
- *Eastlick Aquatics Facility:* Construction of this facility has begun.
- *Bear Center Job Opening:* There is a new job opening at the bear center for a manager position.
- *Adoptions:* 20 horses, 29 zebrafish, 18 beta fish, 6 alpacas, and 6 pigs were adopted out by WSU in 2020.

III. Report by the Attending Veterinarian

- The AV presented the following Adverse Events that were received in February
 - ASAF 6506: [This is a fish-protocol that involves perfusion of a tracer under anesthesia to investigate toxicity in fish]. The group performed perfusions as normal on six fish using the Evan's Blue Dye tracer in combination with another tracer as well as alone and all fish went into cardiac arrest before the procedure was completed. The fish were under anesthesia when this occurred so there were no animal welfare concerns, but the research group is looking into alternative options to Evan's Blue Dye. An adverse events report was submitted and An-an amendment has been recently submitted for the protocol to update the adverse events section and to add alternative tracers.
- The AV presented the list of VVCs approved in February. There were no questions from the committee.
- The AV updated the committee on the following items:
 - ASAF 6686: This protocol uses laboratory mice to investigate the anti-tumoral properties of a photodynamic compound that is expected to destroy tumorous cells upon focal exposure to a laser beam. Previously, a group of five mice became lethargic after treatment and were subsequently euthanized. Another group of mice was more recently treated with a lower <u>dose of the photodynamic</u> <u>compound and shorter intensity-duration of laser exposure and developed a</u>

transient mild lameness that was treated with analgesics and recovered within a few days. and recovered without issues. The mice from the first group were submitted for necropsy, and tissue samples from one of them were collected, for which the histology is still pending.

- ASAF 6816: This is a bone implant study using rats that previously had a few adverse events involving unexpected bone fractures. The study has recently been completed without issues using a new group of animals. No complications or fractures occurred. <u>Radiographs confirmed proper implant placement. The</u> research group is preparing to replicate the experiments soon.
- ASAF 6082: This is a protocol that uses pine siskins to study bird migration cues and behaviors. From A-a group of 9 wild-caught birds, four were found dead in their enclosure or had to be euthanized shortly after being brought back to WSU. A necropsy of one of the deceased birds revealed a salmonella infection. The remaining five were treated with antibiotics. Later, two of them presented injuries and were euthanized. The remaining three developed periocular issues and were euthanized. Samples were collected at necropsy and results are pending. Wild pine siskins have recently experienced a population irruption and an outbreak of salmonella was noted in them by Fish and Wildlife. The group plans to coordinate with Fish and Wildlife and more closely examine wild-caught birds prior to bringing them to WSU in the future.
- *Eastlick Aquatics Facility:* Construction of this facility has begun.
- *Bear Center Job Opening:* There is a new job opening at the bear center for a manager position.
- *Adoptions:* 20 horses, 29 zebrafish, 18 beta fish, 6 alpacas, and 6 pigs were adopted out by WSU in 2020.
