On February 16, 2023, an incident report was filed with the IACUC regarding additional animals erroneously being used on protocol # 201800412. 24 rabbits were approved for a category D procedure but 8 additional rabbits were used for the procedure. Using a higher number of animals that has not been approved by the IACUC can have negative impacts upon the health and welfare of the animals as well as reduce the effectiveness of the IACUC. Any future protocol or significant change in ongoing activities must be approved prior to use. Corrective actions were implemented at the time of the inspection.

This inspection and exit interview were conducted with the attending veterinarian.
