Dear Ms. Guberski,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your August 21, 2018 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Biomere, following up on an initial telephone report on August 17, 2018. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that nine mice died because they had not been monitored following a procedure and recovery from anesthesia. The veterinarian was not called and the Institutional Standard Operating Procedures regarding post-procedural monitoring had not been followed.

The corrective actions consisted of retraining the individual responsible, developing an animal recovery and monitoring form, and training all staff on these procedures.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy.

Dear Director, Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare:

This letter is a follow-up of the preliminary report regarding failure to monitor animals post-procedurally as necessary to ensure well-being during recovery from anesthesia.

This event occurred during a study for the comparison of the immunogenicity and vaccine efficacy of several different HSV-2 gD-2 liposome vaccine prototypes. The first seven groups were initially and successfully administered intranasal test article and sampled for blood and vaginal secretions. In the subsequent five groups a total of nine mice were found dead. The same anesthetic dose was administered to all mice and it is not believed there is any toxicity due to the test articles, similar formulations of which have been dosed many times before without adverse effect.

It was determined animals were not monitored post-procedurally as described in internal Standard Operating Procedures. Appropriate post-procedural monitoring would have allowed for the veterinarian to be contacted immediately. This was an isolated incident and the individual involved will attend a specialized retraining. Corrective actions also include implementing an Animal Recovery and Monitoring Form and group retraining to prevent future incidents.
