This complaint refers to citations on a prior inspection report.						
Animal Care inspectors conduct unannounced inspections for all USDA registered and licensed						
facilities. Our authority is to ensure that they meet the standards required by Federal regulations. We						
also perform inspections in response to valid concerns and complaints received from the public to						
ensure the well-being of the animals and compliance with Federal law.						
When non-compliant items are found, these non-compliances are cited on the inspection report						
under the most accurate regulation based on the circumstances of the issue. Multiple non-						
compliances for the same issue are only cited when appropriate. With the exception of focused inspections, our inspectors evaluate the facility for compliance with all applicable regulations.						
Although all regulatory requirements are assessed, only noncompliant items are listed on the						
inspection report.						
We will continue to inspect this facility to make sure that past non-compliances are corrected and						
that AWA-regulated animals are protected to the fullest extent of Federal law.

It is my understanding that several research animals were allowed to die due to this organization's carelessness. Please levy the maximum allowable fine against Toxikon for their blatant disregard of the Animal Welfare Act (AWA). Most likely these incidents are just the "tip of the iceberg" which leads one to suspect that whatever science is being produced by Toxicon may not hold up to the light of day.

The behavior of this lab cannot be tolerated and must be punished to the fullest extent of the law.
