The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your February 14, 2019 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Harvard Medical School. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that an expired analgesic was used twice in mice. No adverse effects were noted due to use of the drug.

The corrective action consisted of discarding the expired drug, counseling the laboratory staff, and implementing use of a tracking sheet to monitor expiration dates of all drugs used in the laboratory.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy.

This letter serves as a final report on a recent incident of noncompliance that has not been preliminarily reported to OLAW by the Harvard Medical Area Standing Committee on Animals (HMA IACUC).

During a semi-annual IACUC inspection in December 2018, it was discovered that expired xylazine had likely been used two times. According to the ketamine usage records, the xylazine would have been used twice after it expired in August 2018. There was no apparent harm to the mice as a result of this issue.

In response to this issue, the expired xylazine was properly disposed of. The PI discussed this issue at a lab meeting. In addition, the lab now uses a Google sheet tracking all controlled and non-controlled drugs in the lab.

The Committee is satisfied with the corrective actions mentioned above and considers this incident to be resolved. Please let us know if any additional information is required at this time.
