Dear Dr. Murray,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your September 21, 2017 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Creighton University, following up on an initial telephone notification on September 14, 2017. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that the cart which was transporting mice to a testing room bumped into the rough transition of the flooring and resulted in the demise of one mouse as its stacked cage accidentally fell to the ground. The associated animal activity in question was not PHS funded.

The corrective actions consisted of research personnel exercising greater caution when transporting animals, prohibiting the stacking of cages on transport carts and using carts that are equipped with sides exclusively when transporting animals.

Based on the information provided, OLAW is satisfied that appropriate actions have been taken to investigate, correct and prevent recurrence of the noncompliance. Your prompt and thorough resolution of this matter is commendable and consistent with the PHS Policy philosophy of monitored self-regulation. We appreciate having been informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this Office.

Creighton University is submitting a finalized report regarding an animal welfare issue that was reported to the IACUC office on August 3, 2017. The University's Research Compliance Auditor for the Office of Research Compliance made the initial report to you via phone on September 14, 2017.

Background Information/Animal Welfare Issue:

On July 31, 2017, during transportation from an animal room to a testing room, one mouse died. A cart used to transport animal cages was being wheeled down a hallway that contains a rough transition from one floor type to another. During this trip the cart bumped the transition and lurched. As a result, one of the animal cages that was stacked on top of others was jostled and inadvertently fell from the top of the cart. In the incident report submitted to the IACUC, one mouse was observed to be dead immediately following impact.

Corrective Action Plan Taken:

The incident report submitted to the IACUC included the PI's proposed corrective plan of action:

Greater caution will be used when transporting animals between the traversing floors

The IACUC agreed with the plan of action provided by the PI; however, they also requested the PI's staff follow additional directives to ensure future compliance:

- Research personnel will not stack cages on transporting cart; if necessary, multiple trips will be taken
- Research personnel will only use carts with sides for transportation to ensure cages cannot slide off

Reporting:

The following organization will be contacted regarding this noncompliance:

• The Association for Assessment and Accreditation of Laboratory Animal Care International (AAALAC) will be informed of this noncompliance.

No additional reporting is required to other agencies or organizations as this protocol was not Public Health Service (PHS) funded at the time the incident occurred.
