Dear Dr. Murray,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your May 29, 2018 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Creighton University. This issue was reported to our office by phone on April 25th. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that on March 19th six dead pinkies were found in a cage containing only a male adult mouse. The female had been removed when found dead on March 15th. Apparently the pinkies were nestled in the bedding and not seen when the female was removed. The activity to which the mice were assigned was not funded by the PHS.

Corrective actions included the PI meeting with research personnel to discuss the issue and require them to re-read all protocols. The PI's staff created a "REMINDER" to place on the inside of the animal room to remind all personnel to "Check for pups if an adult is removed and verify the sex of the remaining animal in cage" prior to exiting the room. In addition, all oral communication between the ARF and research staff will be followed-up with written instructions via email.

The prompt consideration of this matter by Creighton University was consistent with the philosophy of institutional self-regulation. Similarly, the actions taken to resolve the issue and prevent recurrence were appropriate. We appreciate being informed of this matter and find no cause for further action by this office.

Dear Dr. Wolff:

Creighton University is submitting a finalized report regarding an animal welfare issue that was initially reported to you via phone on April 25, 2018 by the Research Compliance Auditor.

Background Information/Animal Welfare Issue:

On March 19, 2018 6 dead pinkies were found by the Animal Resource Facility (ARF) personnel during rounds. Upon further examination of the cage, it was discovered the 6 dead pinkies were housed with 1 adult male. The respective cage card noted 1 dead female was removed from the cage on March 15, 2018.

Following discussion with research personnel, it is believed that the pinkies were nestled in the bedding and were not seen at the time the female was removed. Standard practice would have been to euthanize or foster the pinkies had they been observed when the dead female was removed.

Corrective Action Plan Taken:

The following corrective action plan was formulated by the PI in conjunction with a subcommittee of the IACUC:

- The PI met with the research personnel to discuss the nature of the incident and required the research staff to re-read all protocols.
- The PI's staff created a "REMINDER" to place on the inside of the animal room to remind all personnel to "Check for pups if an adult is removed and verify the sex of the remaining animal in cage" prior to exiting the room.
- Moving forward all oral communication between the ARF and research staff will be followed-up
 with written instructions via email for clarification.


